

The house sleeps up to 12 people with the possibility of adding a further two camp beds for children. All linen, crockery, cutlery and cooking utensils are supplied.

Directions to Koru are as follows:

From Nakuru, drive to Kericho. 2 km. after the Kericho Barclays Bank (on the right hand side of the road) turn right to Kisumu. Follow the Kisumu road for 30 km. then turn right to Muhoroni, by the bus shelter. You will see the first signboard for Homa Lime at this junction. After 8 km. along a tarred road you will see the second sign board, opposite the Muhoroni Sugar Factory. Turn right along another tarred road for 9 km. until the third sign board. Turn left onto the dirt road, cross the railway line and then turn left at the fourth sign. After the bridge, drive straight on until you see the signs for Kweisos.

Tarriff:

Minimum charge of KSh.5,000.00 per day.

Self Catering - KSh. 2,000.00 per person per day.

Self Catering Child - under 12 years Kshs 1,500.00

Full Board - Ksh. 6,000.00 per person per day.

All activities on the premises are free of charge except for horse riding which will cost KSh. 1,500.00 per person per hour and by arrangement with the Brooks, not the syce (groom).

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KWEISOS HOUSE

KORU



“Kweisos” means the place of palms. This is derived from the Kipsigis word “Sosiyot”. The midribs of the local palms, Phoenix reclinata, are used for cleaning out the insides of calabashes, which are then used as containers for liquids.



Kweisos House which was built in the 1920's, is situated at Homa Lime in Koru. Access is by all-weather roads suitable for 2-WD vehicles, only the last 5 km. being on unsealed roads.

Enjoy home grown, home cooked traditional Farmhouse Cooking. The house has it's own kitchen where our staff prepare your meals or picnics if you would like to eat out on the farm or elsewhere. If you prefer to cater for yourself you may bring your own food or obtain farm produce from us.



Walk or drive (4-w.d.) around the 3000 acre estate at your leisure and enjoy the superb bird watching opportunities, walking and fishing on small dams for tilapia, catfish or bass. There is a guide available, who will take you to the Waterfall, Sticky Dam, the Booze

Cruise or the Arboretum.

At Kweisos there is a heated swimming pool and at Greenhills there are two excellent clay tennis courts, full size snooker table, badminton, darts and table tennis for your use. Horse riding is also available, with some wonderful hacks around the estate, and also a cross-country course for more experienced riders.



For the keener fisherman, fishing for Nile perch on Lake Victoria or for trout in the dams in Kericho can be arranged.

Centrally located for golfers, the house is within one hour's drive of three very different nine-hole courses in Kisumu, Kericho and Nandi Hills. The latter must be one of the most beautiful courses in the country.



Within a day's outing are the Kakamega Forest, renowned for it's rain forest type flora and fauna; the Kerio Valley, which offers spectacular scenery and dry country birding; and the little known Ruma National Park, home of the Roan Antelope and a host of other animals and birds.



We are ideally situated for those on the way to Uganda, being half way between Nairobi and Kampala and for those of you wishing to break journey on the way to the Mara, Mt. Elgon, the west shore of Lake Turkana and the islands on Lake Victoria, the farmhouse is an ideal stop off point.
